

Joint Planning Support Element

The Joint Planning Support Element (JPSE) provides rapidly deployable, tailored teams of joint planners for operational and strategic headquarters with expertise to accelerate the formation and increase the effectiveness of a joint force headquarters during emerging operations.

JPSE, headquartered at Naval Station Norfolk, Va., provides flexible, employable packages composed of personnel who are experienced in joint operations, understand joint doctrine and are trained in the Joint Operation Planning Process.

JPSE provides expertise in:

- **Plans** to leverage joint expertise and use current best practices to ensure the integrated employment of land, air, maritime and information operations.
- **Operations** to enhance situational understanding and facilitate the execution of current operations.
- **Logistics** to integrate, coordinate and implement joint logistics operations and planning.
- **Knowledge Management** to develop and implement knowledge management plans and processes to provide increased situational awareness across the command and support/enhance the commander's decision cycle.
- **Intelligence Support** to coordinate, manage and synchronize intelligence collection, analysis and dissemination.

An integral part of the Department of Defense's efforts to strengthen joint operations and improve joint command and control capability, JPSE provides tailored, functional planning teams designed to meet historical, real-world demand signals from the geographic combatant commands.

JPSE deploys on short notice to assist joint force commanders for a broad range of missions including support for humanitarian assistance / disaster relief operations.

JPSE operational support can be received through Global Response Force requests, the Request for Forces process or requests by General Officers/Flag Officers. JPSE exercise support can be requested through the Joint Training Information Management System.
