



Joint Enabling Capabilities Command Chief of Staff Colonel Mark E. Brock United States Army



Colonel Mark Brock received his commission as a 2nd Lieutenant in the Field Artillery through the Reserve Officer Training Corps program at Oklahoma State University. He most recently served as the Deputy J37 for United States Forces Korea. His assignments include the 24th Infantry Division at Fort Benning, Georgia, 75th Field Artillery Brigade at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, the 3rd Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia and Commander of the 6th Battalion, 37th Field Artillery Regiment at Camp Casey, South Korea.

After graduating from the Field Artillery Officer's Basic Course, he served as the Reconnaissance and Survey Officer, Platoon Fire Direction Officer, Ammunition Platoon Leader and Company Fire Support Officer for 4th Battalion, 41st Field Artillery Regiment. From there, he attended the Infantry Officer Advanced Course at Fort Benning. After graduation from the Advanced Course, he joined the 1st Battalion, 77th Field Artillery at Fort Sill as the Battalion S4 and then commanded Alpha Battery. Later, he moved to Fort Chaffee, Arkansas to work as a firing battery observer trainer followed by assignment as the Battalion Operations Officer for 3rd Battalion, 393rd Field Artillery.

As a major, he held several positions in the 3rd Infantry Division. The positions included the Fires and Effects Planner for the Division, Battalion Operations Officer and Executive Officer for 1st Battalion, 76th Field Artillery, the 4th Brigade Fire Support Officer and the 1st Armored Brigade Executive Officer. Prior to moving to the Republic of Korea, he was the Targeting Division Chief for the Joint and Combined Integration Directorate at Fort Sill.

He is a graduate of the Field Artillery Officer Basic Course, Infantry Officer Advanced Course, the Combined Arms and Services Staff School, Joint Firepower Control Course, Joint Operational Fires and Effects Course, the Command and General Staff College and the School for Advanced Military Studies.

COL Brock holds a bachelor's degree in Animal Science from Oklahoma State University, a master's degree in International Relations from Troy University, and a Master's degree from the Command and General Staff College at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.

His awards include the Defense Superior Service Medal, Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, and Army Achievement Medal.
